## Super 60 Reading

Your number 1 priority for home learning!
Aim for at least 60 minutes of reading a week.
10 minutes, 6 days a week / 15 minutes, 4 times a week?
Make sure that read out loud to an adult at least 3 times a week.



#### <u>Retrieval quiz</u>

(10 minutes each week)

This is a really important part of your homework. We have covered all of these skills in school. I'd like to keep them fresh in your mind, so your job is to reflect back to when we learnt the concept or skill and talk about your response to an adult. There is no need to write anything down! I am interested in your thinking and discussion. We will have a quiz on this in school to see how much you can remember.

### <u>Big Maths CLIC, SAFE and Learn its quiz</u>

(10 minutes each week)

Take a look at your most recent quiz sheets and celebrate those questions that you got right (not highlighted). Work on a highlighted question at home (resources will be available to help).

#### I will only ask you to work on one incorrect question type.

The aim is to improve your score each week, even if this is just one question at a time.

(20 minutes each week)

On this sheet I'd like you to complete each task carefully, taking pride in your work. These tasks will help you in the next week's English lessons and in the spelling quiz.
